uPlan, powered by UGate

Want an explanation about UGate vs. UPlan?

UGate is the database warehouse for UDOT GIS data. This central repository pulls data from many other databases at UDOT into one location where it can be easily shared through the UDOT [Data Portal](#). A [guide](#), available on the Data Portal, can help you find the best data match for your needs.

[UPlan](#), the most visible GIS product at UDOT, is a web mapping application and a collection of maps populated with data that comes from UGate. UPlan is built upon ESRI ArcGIS.com software. While UPlan has a database storage component, the majority of data displayed is supplied by the UGate data warehouse.
