# Request a new data layer:

Just click on the 'Request a Layer' button on the <u>Data Portal</u> and fill out an online request form.

The UDOT Data Portal is a one-stop shop for GIS data, applications, news and training.

### **New Explorer App Boldly Goes**

Explorer for ArcGIS, available for iOS and Android devices, is a new app for interacting with UDOT data.

ArcGIS for iOS and Android were the first apps provided by ArcGIS Online for using UDOT's UPlan maps on a mobile device. A new app, Explorer, is the most current app, and the only app that will be continually updated with new features. #### Where's Marwan?
