A new map with is helping to coordinate maintenance projects in Region Two.

Breakout Period 2 -- Intro to UPEL

Planning and Environmental Linkages, or UPEL, is a web-based app that generates reports for preliminary environmental assessment. UPEL has recently been reconfigured to work faster.

Because UPEL delivers essential, complex environmental data quickly, it boosts efficiency, saves project costs, and supports a better decision-making process.

The Data Portal is a one stop shop for UDOT data and tools, including Open Data, UPlan, Linear Bench, Highway Reference Online and Report Auto Generator. This session will include an introduction to what is available and highlight new mapping galleries.
