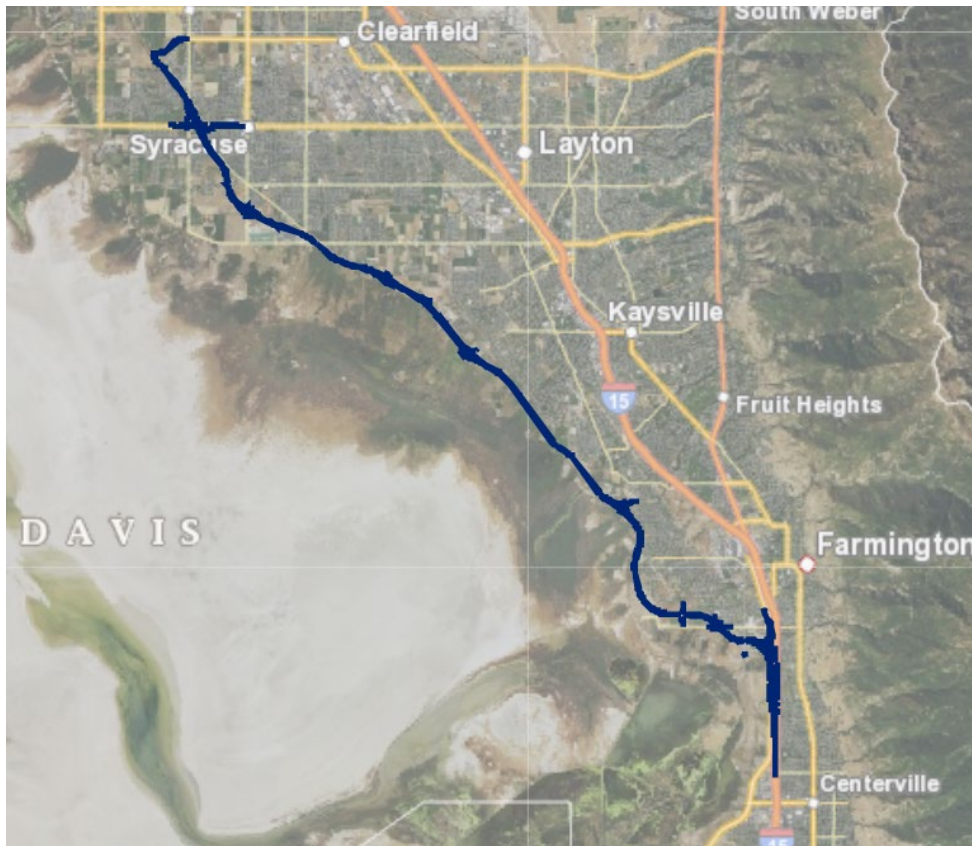


SR-177, West Davis Hwy: I-15 & SR-67 to SR-193

Davis County



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is building a new 16-mile, 4-lane divided highway from I-15 and Legacy Parkway to SR-193 in western Davis County. Grade-separated interchanges will be built at Legacy/I-15 (Farmington), 950 North (Farmington), 200 North (Kaysville), 2700 West (Layton), 2000 West (Syracuse), and Antelope Drive (Syracuse). Over 10 miles of new trail and connections will be built. Hundreds of acres of wetlands and wildlife habitat to be preserved and protected.

BENEFITS

Meet travel demand through 2040. Improve access to western Davis County and reduce congestion on I-15 and east-west roadways. Provide a new trail and trail connections. Protect wetlands and wildlife habitat.
