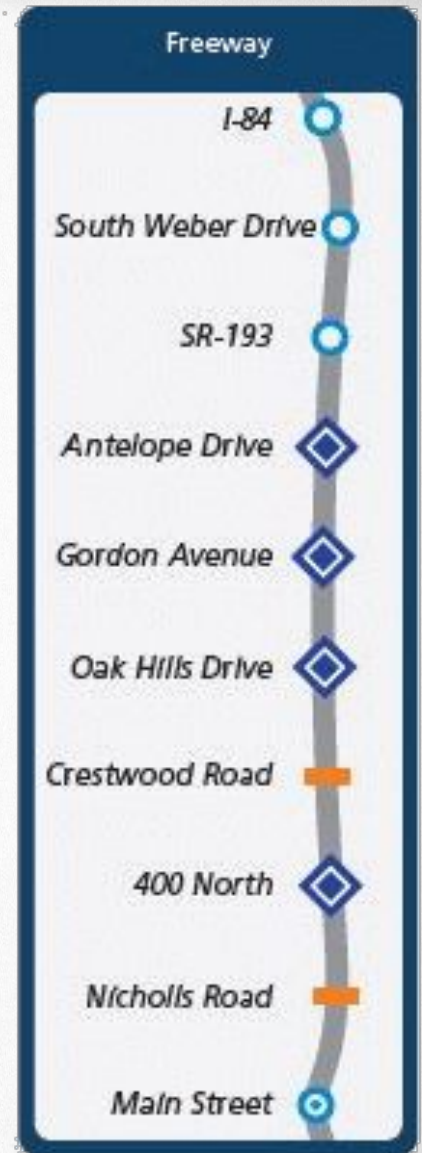

## CURRENT FUNDING SCOPE

**\$275 Million**

- 6 Lanes to Crestwood Road
- 400 North Interchange
- Nicholls Road Crossing
- Crestwood Road Crossing
- Eastside Frontage Road 400 N to 1250 N
- Lloyd Road Extension
- Main Street Ramp Improvements
- Trail from Valley View Dr. to South Weber

## RECOMMENDED SCOPE

**\$498 Million**

In addition to the items above:

- 6 Lanes to SR-193
- Oak Hills Drive Interchange
- Gordon Avenue Interchange & Extension
- Antelope Drive Interchange
- Pavement Rehabilitation SR-193 to I-84
- West Side Frontage Road Connections
- Ped Crossing in South Weber
- Widen Weber River Bridge for a free right from eastbound I-84 to southbound US-89
